- A supervising adult must be present with youth vendors under the age of 16.
- All vendors must provide their own change. No change will be provided.
- Each vendor must display a sign identifying the name of the vendor/business.
- Food vendors are required to know and have appropriate labeling on their products.

- Kids Market products/services/businesses must be primarily provided/run by the child participating with minimal help from the parent or guardian.
- There is no cost for Kids' Day Market Vendors
- No call/no shows will not be considered for future markets.
- Vendor participation is subject to approval of the market committee and is not guaranteed. You will be notified on or before June 22nd, 2026 after a decision has been made. Space is limited and is on a first come basis. NO DROP INS are allowed, you must preregister.

Hold Harmless Agreement

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By signing this agreement, a Vendor agrees to:

Indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Plainwell, its officers, employees, volunteers, and agents from any and all losses, costs, expenses, claims, liabilities, actions, or damages, including liability for injuries to any person or persons or damage to property arising at any time during and/or arising out of or in any way connected with Vendor's use or occupancy of the Facility (Farmers Market) and adjoining property.

Comply and/or will comply with all applicable and appropriate laws, rules and regulations pertaining to participation in the Farmers Market and agree to comply with all Michigan Department of Agriculture Rules and Regulations, the Michigan Cottage Food Law, and applicable US Department of Agriculture (USDA) laws and regulations relating to its food, product, or goods.

A vendor of all baked and/or processed foods agrees to follow current Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development rules (MDARD). If you are required to create your food product in a licensed food kitchen you will obtain a license from MDARD or USDA for the preparation process.

A vendor selling processed foods agrees to label them according to MDARD and USDA rules. It is suggested, not required, that vendors selling processed foods should obtain a minimum of \$500,000 product liability insurance for their own protection.

A vendor agrees to provide appropriate and required licenses with the City of Plainwell and maintain a copy at the Facility during the event. Vendors will not be allowed to operate at the Facility until such has been filed.
